Harbor/Pasadena (110) Fwy North to Orange Grove Blvd. exit. Turn left onto Orange Grove Blvd., proceed south and turn right on California Blvd., proceed south and turn right on California Blvd. Go past main entrance and turn right on Fairmount Ave.
